Specific Discounts provided for in Article 27.3 of the Law 48/2003, to be applied during the Year 2009 by the Port Authority of Cartagena, to Vessel, Passenger and Goods Rates.

**Approved by the Board of Directors of the Port Authority of Cartagena, at the ordinary session held on 25th November 2008.**

**B.1.- VESSEL RATE:**

**B.1.1.- Container Vessels<sup>(\*)</sup>**

According to the number of tons of containerized goods handled in the Port of Cartagena during the calendar year by the same regular container line, the following staggered discounts shall be applied:

From 0 Tn. to 200,000 Tn	<b>15 %</b>
From 200,001 Tn. to 300,000 Tn	<b>25 %</b>
As of 300,001 Tn	<b>30 %</b>
By increasing the number of calls by more than 50% (*)	<b>40 %</b>

(\*) This discount shall be applied during a temporary period of FOUR (4) MONTHS and shall be incompatible with regard to the previous discounts.

(\*) This discount may not be requested more than once every three years.

This specific Discount shall be applied starting from the call in which the Shipping Company/ Shipping Agent that renders this regular line service, notifies the Port Authority that there shall be an increase in the number of calls at the port equivalent to more than 50% of the average number of calls made over the previous twelve months, and it is confirmed that the frequency of the number of calls has indeed increased. This discount shall be incompatible with regard to other discounts applied to the vessel rate already approved by the Port Authority of Cartagena.

From 0 to 5,000 cargo units	<b>20 %</b>
From 5,001 to 10,000 cargo units	<b>25 %</b>
From 10,001 to 15,000 cargo units	<b>30 %</b>
From 15,001 to 20,000 cargo units	<b>35 %</b>
More than 20,000 cargo units	<b>40 %</b>
